- o Unemployment (For all adults in the household)
- o Court ordered Child Support or Alimony
- o Social Security or Disability statement (For all adults in household)
- o IF YOU HAVE NO FORMS OF INCOME, YOU MUST PROVIDE A LETTER FROM THE PERSON SUPPORTING YOU AND A REFERRAL LETTER FROM SOMEONE NOT RELATED TO YOU (School, clergy, caseworker, etc.)
